Road Closure Notification

The carriageway resurfacing works originally due to commence on 20th-22nd May have been postponed due to urgent utility works to be undertaken by a third party contractor. Whilst these works are unrelated to the Jermyn Street Public Realm project, it is necessary for these utility works to be undertaken prior to any resurfacing works taking place to ensure the new carriageway isn't excavated after it has been completed.

The new dates for these works are outlined below. Further updates of these works will be provided via email:

- The carriageway resurfacing to take place on Jermyn Street between Princes Arcade and St James's Street and on Duke Street St James's between Piccadilly and Mason's Yard will now commence from **10th - 12th June**. These works will be undertaken during normal working hours.
- Carriageway resurfacing will take place St. James's Street between Piccadilly and Ryder Street in the southbound direction and on St James's Street between Piccadilly and the Bennet Street junction in the northbound lane. These works are expected to go ahead as planned on the **23rd and 24th May**. In the case of these works also being postponed, you will be contacted via email. These works are due to be undertaken overnight.

The installation of the raised granite sett table at the junction of Duke Street St James's and Jermyn Street has also been postponed. These works are due to commence on **17th June** and last for approximately 7 weeks.
